

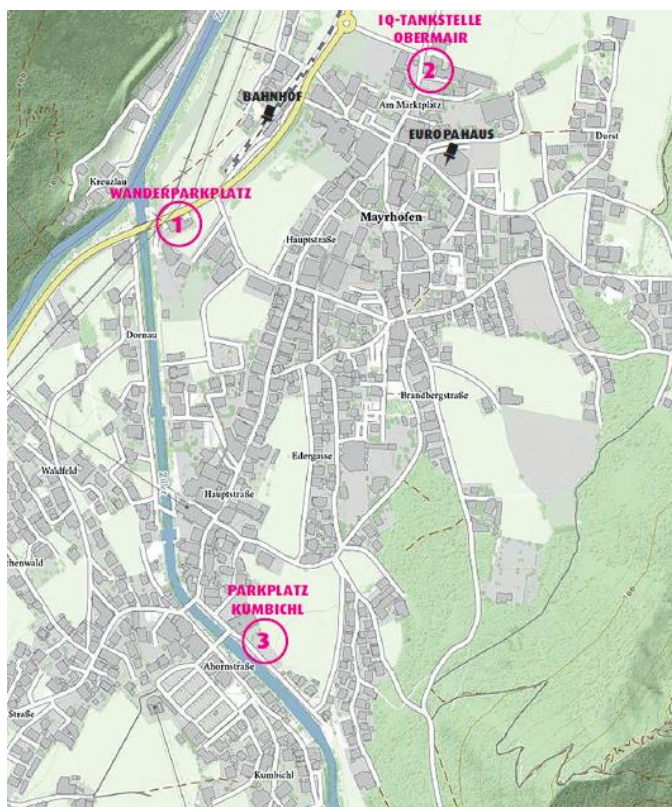


## Parking for Hikers In the Mayrhofen-Hippach Holiday Destination

Are you planning a hike or hut to hut tour and do not know where you can park your car? There are special car parks for long-term parking in the Mayrhofen-Hippach holiday destination:

### Parking in Mayrhofen:

- **Parking place "old BP petrol station" hiking park spaces of the family Hannes Pfister.**  
You can purchase the parking permit at the tourist board Mayrhofen-Hippach in the Europahaus. The price is € 40,00 per car for a parking period of 7 days. Only possible until September!

- **Parking place „IQ Tankstelle“**  
The parking permit you can purchase directly at the petrol station. The price is € 7,00 per car for one day.  
Number 2
- **Parking place Kumbichl**  
**ATTENTION:** If you are several days on the road, (guests of the Edelhütte, Berlin High Trail etc.) you will get an exit ticket at the ticket office of the Ahornbahn to their roundtrip-ticket. The first day is FREE - Each additional day costs € 8,80.

### Parking in Ginzling:

There are several opportunities for day parking in Ginzling.

- Next to the Nature Park House (please do not use the visitor parking spaces).
- The music pavilion.
- Next to the bus stop at Guest House "Alt Ginzling".
- A charge is made for the car park at Guest House Breitlahner:
- Attention: Ticket Automat (coins required!)

Car parking is also available at the Schlegeis Reservoir. It is necessary, however, to leave your car registration number and a contact phone number at the toll station or restaurant and let them know that you are on the Berlin High Trail. Cars that have been left for longer than one week without the owner leaving information on his/her whereabouts may be towed away, or even trigger an "emergency situation" – as one could quite rightly assume that something has happened to the hiker(s).
